Though it may seem that we have nothing, if we are reconciled to you, we possess everything through Jesus Christ our Lord. Amen.

**CALL TO CONFESSION** 

Leader: In quiet trust, in simple words, we enter a space for prayer. As we confess our sins, both secret and public, the door to God's heart is open, and we enter into grace and mercy. Let us pray:
